LEAGUE FORMAT

The league format is to play 6 Singles, followed by 1 Scotch Doubles, then a further 6 Singles as set out below. Notice that in the second half of the 6 Singles the home teams positions stay the same but the away teams positions have changed, they have all moved up 1 place, this is so no one will play the same person twice. Every game won will be awarded a team point with 2 points awarded to the winning team overall on the night. Each player can only earn 1 merit point per match and it is awarded on the first frame that the player plays. For Example:- if a player plays in frame 1 in the first set of singles and then again in frame 8 in the second set of singles their merit point will be awarded on frame 1 only. If a player is dropped from the first set of singles and another player replaces them in the second set of singles they must stay in the same position. For example:- Player 3 drops out then the new player MUST play in PLAYER 3 position.

PLAYER NEEDS TO LEAVE EARLY.

If you have a player who needs to leave early then if you are the home player they should play in position 1. If you have a player who needs to leave early then if you are the Away player they should play in position 2. So the first two frames shall be played and then frame 8 in the second set of singles matches should be played. See table below:-
